

# UK Fluids Network dissertation prize 2020

The UKFN invites nominations for the best Fluid Mechanics-themed doctoral thesis from 2019. The winner will receive a prize of £500.

## 1. Eligibility

Eligible dissertations should be in a fluids-related subject and submitted to a UK university for a doctoral degree between 1 January 2019 and 31 December 2019.

## 2. Nomination and selection process

A thesis is nominated for the prize by one of the thesis examiners, using the template given below. Besides details of the candidate and their thesis, the examiner must give a citation in around 300-500 words saying why they think it is an outstanding dissertation. They must also include a second citation, of similar length, from the other examiner.

Nominations should be sent to [competition@fluids.ac.uk](mailto:competition@fluids.ac.uk) by **30 April 2020**.

The nominations will be evaluated by a panel composed of members of the UKFN Executive Committee, and the winner will be announced on 31 May 2020.
